Can you imagine the profile of an eagle in the 10-foot-high remnant of Washington Township's Liberty Tree at Schooley's Mountain and Flocktown roads? Bernardsville wood sculptor Harry Robinson can. Robinson, pictured leaning against a fallen section of trunk as the Morris County Shade Tree Commission cut the dead, 280-year-old white oak March 13, has been commissioned by the township for \$3,500 to give the tree a second life this spring.
