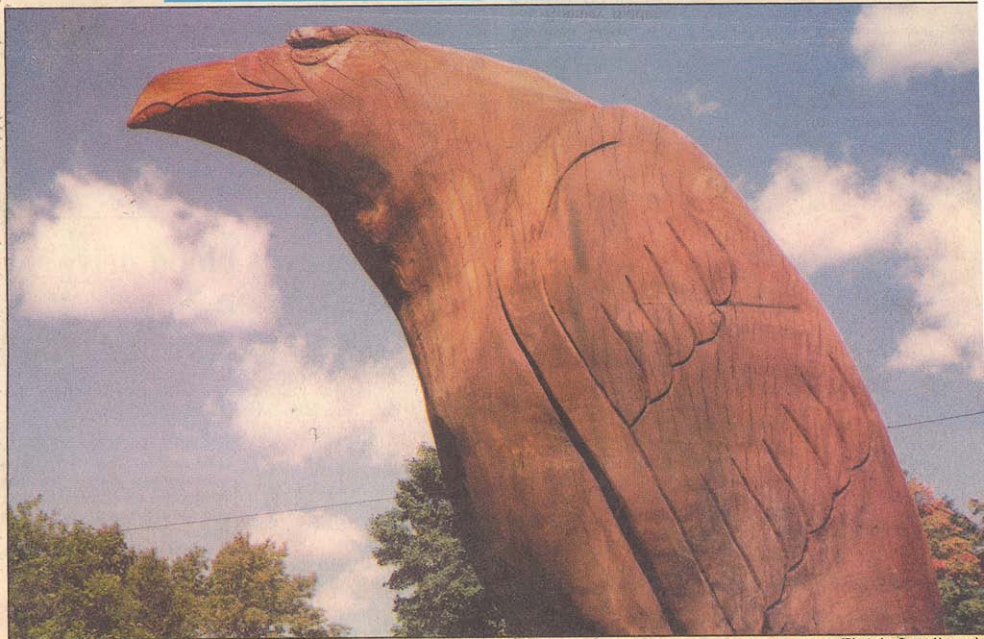

Veteran's Day Dedication Planned

Washington Township officials plan to dedicate this wood sculpture of our national symbol at 11 a.m. on Veteran's Day, Nov. 11. The eagle was sculpted by Harry Robinson of Bernardsville from the "Liberty Tree" at Schooley's Mountain and Flocktown roads. The 280-year-old tree succumbed to disease on March 13 and the Township Committee commissioned Robinson for \$3,500 to transform the tree's 10-foot-high remains into this monument. The police will close off Heath Lane to traffic during the Nov. 11 ceremony. Veterans' groups, Eagle Scouts, Girl Scouts, and sculptor Robinson and his family are among those invited to the dedication.
