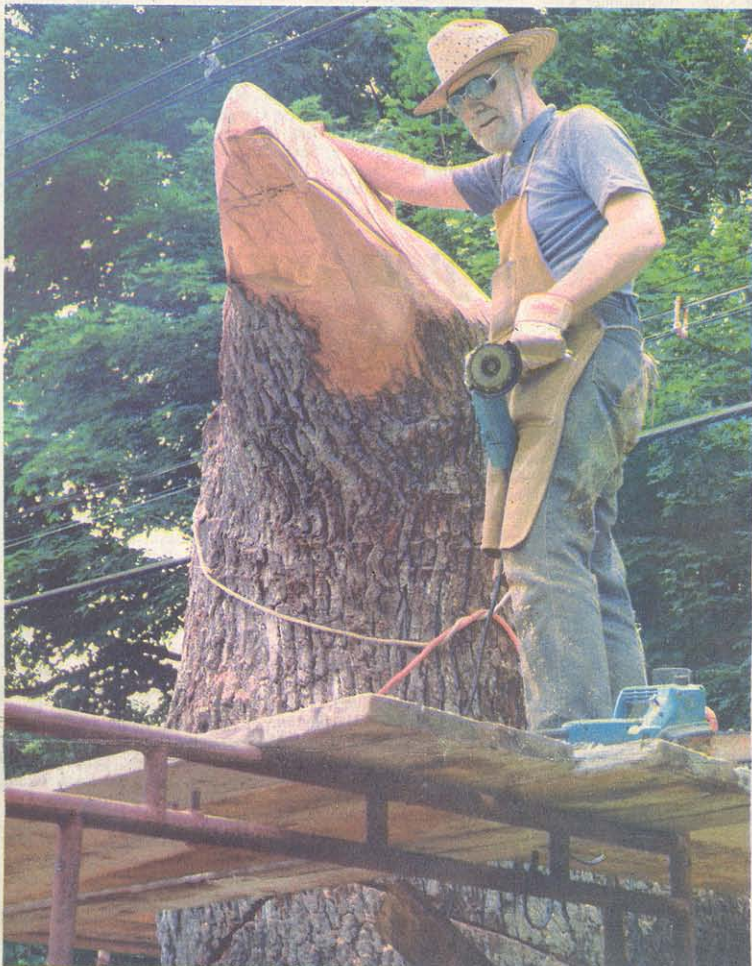


# National Symbol Takes Shape



The massive profile of America's national symbol is emerging from the wood of the Liberty Tree at Schooley's Mountain and Flocktown roads, the site of a memorial to war veterans. Bernardsville wood sculptor Harry Robinson has been commissioned by the Washington Township Committee for \$3,500 to transform the 10-foot-high remains of the old white oak into an eagle. The 280-year-old tree, a Schooley's Mountain landmark steeped in township history and lore, finally succumbed to disease and chainsaws on March 13.
