## Symbol Of Liberty

The "Liberty Tree" at Schooley's Mountain and Flocktown roads in Washington Township has given birth to a "Liberty Eagle." The 280-year-old tree, a Schooley's Mountain landmark, succumbed to disease on March 13. The Township Committee commissioned wood sculptor Harry Robinson of Bernardsville for \$3,500 to transform the 10-foot-high remains of the old white oak into a monumental depiction of America's national symbol.
