For ages 2 years old to 5th grade. Children who have completed 5th grade may join the Teen Reading Club.

** All children may participate by reading on their own or by being read to. Children may read anything they like; materials from home as well as from the library; books, magazines, comics, books on tape/CD, etc.

** Calendars should be used to keep track of the number of minutes read by the children (or the number of minutes read to). Please keep track of reading time in TEN MINUTE INTERVALS. A check or a stroke may be used to indicate each ten minute interval. (For example, | | | = 30 minutes of reading).

** Tally your minutes and once each week (beginning Monday, June 28th) bring in your calendar to have the number of minutes read recorded. Recording of minutes may be done all day Monday - Friday & Saturday(10 - 1pm only)

** Participants will receive prizes after reading 250 minutes and every 250 minutes following up to 2000 minutes. The library staff will keep track of the participant's progress in reading logs kept at the library.

** Every 1000 minutes read will entitle the participant to a **FREE BOOK** (Max4 free books per participant).

** Participants may chose to join either the Terrific Tubers or the Super Surfers Each child's minutes will be added to his/her team's total. The progress of the two teams will be displayed in the Children's Section.

** Remember to keep track of your reading even while on vacation.

** Each week there will be a Weekly Seaside Search - questions for participants to answer. Children answering the question correctly will be entered into a raffle to win additional prizes.

The Summer Reading Club will end on Wednesday, August 11th.
